



LETTER OF COLLABORATION (“LoC”)

Between

Universiti Teknologi Malaysia, an institution of higher learning established under the Universities and University Colleges Act 1971 (Act 30) whose address is at Universiti Teknologi Malaysia, 81310 Johor Bahru, Johor Darul Ta’zim, Malaysia (hereinafter referred to as “UTM”) of the first part;

And

Universitas Pattimura – Ambon Maluku, a public higher education institution which established on 23 April 1963 whose address is at Jalan Ir. M. Putuhena Kampus Poka Ambon, Indonesia and shall include its lawful representatives and permitted assigns (hereinafter referred to as “UNPATTI”) of the second part.

UTM and UNPATTI here to shall be referred to individually as a “Party” and collectively as “Parties”.

1.0 Field of collaboration

1.1 Collaboration between the parties will include the research collaboration and promotion of academic in the areas of Science and Technology and other disciplines offered at the two institutions.

2.0 Areas of Collaboration and Support

2.1 The parties agree and acknowledge that collaboration may develop in the following, but not limited to:

- a) Collaboration of joint proposal for national and international funding agencies (e.g. AUN-SEED, LPDP, and Environment Foundation (KWEF), Asian Development Bank, etc.);
- b) Exchange information and materials of academic activity in mutual interest;
- c) Promote and facilitate the exchange of research and teaching staff as well as students for research student exchanges, staff exchanges, joint research, joint supervision and joint research training;
- e) Organize international collaboration such as conference, symposium, cultural and sports activities
- f) Other related fields as mutual agreed in future.

2.2 For the purpose of implementing the collaboration in respect of any areas stated in paragraph 2.1, where any activities may give rise to rights and obligations between the parties, a separate legally binding agreement shall be entered into for each activity, subject to the approval of both parties.

1.0 Field of collaboration

2.0 Areas of Collaboration and Support

2.1 The parties agree and acknowledge that collaboration may develop in the following, but not limited to:

- b) Exchange information and materials of academic activity in mutual interest;
- c) Promote and facilitate the exchange of research and teaching staff as well as students for research student exchanges, staff exchanges, joint research, joint supervision and joint research training;
- e) Organize international collaboration such as conference, symposium, cultural and sports activities
- f) Other related fields as mutual agreed in future.

2.2 For the purpose of implementing the collaboration in respect of any areas stated in paragraph 2.1, where any activities may give rise to rights and obligations between the parties, a separate legally binding agreement shall be entered into for each activity, subject to the approval of both parties.

3.0 Duration and Termination

- a) This LoC shall enter into force at the day of signature by the signatory of each party and shall remain in force for three (3) years unless terminated by one of the parties giving three (3) months written notice to the other.
- b) This LoC may be extended for a further period as maybe agreed in writing by the parties.
- c) Where such termination occurs, the provision of the collaborative programs shall continue to apply to on-going activities until their completion.

4.0 Confidentiality

Each party shall only use the other party's confidential information which is communicated to it in connection with this LoC for the purpose for which it was communicated or with the permission of the communicating party.

5.0 Intellectual property

- 5.1 Nothing in this LoC alters or affects the ownership of any intellectual property which is communicated by one party to another.
- 5.2 In order to preserve intellectual property rights, any research findings and inventions arising from the joint activities under this LoC shall be the intellectual property rights of both parties. Final disposition of the said intellectual property rights will be subjected to mutual agreement between both parties. Neither party will have any claim on previously existing intellectual property owned by that respective party.

6.0 Cost and Expenses

Any cost and expenses incurred in performing any activity pursuant to the collaborative programs shall be negotiated to the mutual acceptance of both parties.

7.0 General

- 7.1 Each party will assign a person to be in charge of the implementation and maintenance including negotiation and management of this LoC.
